

IFO (IDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT) -



JAQUES RIVAL BATTLE BRIDGE PLACE Created by French artist and architect Jaques Rival. By day, IFO acts as a framing device for the daily theatre of the street. While at night it becomes a luminous spectrum, re-emitting the energy it has accumulated during the day.

2 JOINING THE DOTS - CLEARY CONNOLLY GERMAN GYMNASIUM



A video installation inspired by Gunnar Johnsson, exploring motion of the body recreated in 13 moving points.

3 KING'S CROSS TUNNEL - SPIER + MAJOR / ALLIES & MORRISON



PANCRAS TUNNEL LINK A 90m long pedestrian tunnel with LED lightwall designed by Allies & Morrison, linking St Pancras International and King's Cross St Pancras Underground stations to King's Cross.

4 LIGHT GRAFFITI - FLOATING PICTURES



KING'S BOULEVARD Be creative and take part in this interactive light projection using your smartphone light.



5 BINARYWAVES - LAB[AU]



REGENT'S CANAL This installation uses infrared sensors to capture readings from mobile phones, radios and cars - and transforming them into a unique display of light, sound and colour.

GRANARY SQUARE A giant Big Top projected onto the Granary building. The project has involved residents of King's Cross. The result is an animated magical world of music and mayhem.

9 DIVER - RON HASELDEN




Set above King's Cross pond - watch this moving light piece dive into the water.
