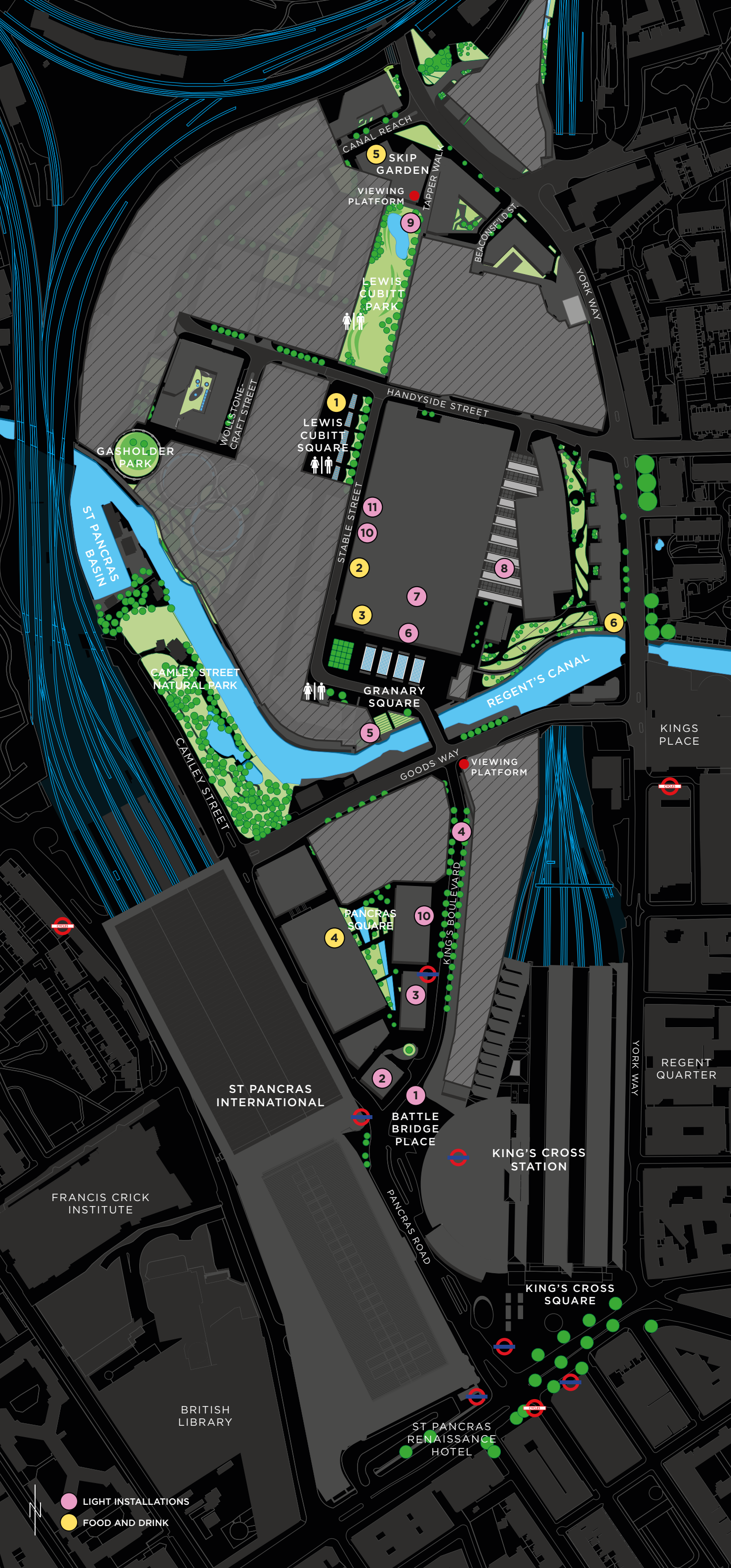

IFO (IDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECT) - JAKUES RIVAL
BATTLE BRIDGE PLACE
Created by French artist and architect Jaques Rival. By day, IFO acts as a framing device for the daily theatre of the street. While at night it becomes a luminous spectrum, re-emitting the energy it has accumulated during the day.

GERMAN GYMNASIUM
A video installation inspired by Gunnar Johansson, exploring motion of the body recreated in 13 moving points.

PANCRAS TUNNEL LINK
A 90m long pedestrian tunnel with LED lightwall designed by Allies & Morrison, linking St Pancras International and King's Cross St Pancras Underground stations to King's Cross.
